

Getting to Oxford and St. Clare's

Arrivals day is the date published for the start of the course. Unfortunately, we are not able to accommodate you in college if you arrive early. If you do wish to arrive before 14.00 hrs you will need to stay in a hotel or guest-house. Have a look at the local [Daily Information website](#) for hotel and guest-house details.

Flights

When booking flights, please remember that the Arrival Day for the course is always the first date of your course. The departure day is the last date given for your course. You need to arrive and depart on these days. We cannot accept students before Arrival Day or allow students to stay after Departure Day. If you wish to spend some time in Oxford either before or after your course, you must arrange your own accommodation e.g. a hotel – please see the Daily Information website above.

Travelling to St. Clare's by bus or train

St. Clare's is located just 1.5 km from the centre of Oxford. It is easy to get to Oxford by bus from the airports or by train from London.

The cheapest way to get to Oxford is by bus. To plan your journey look at the [Oxford Bus Company Airline website](#). When you arrive in Oxford, either at the bus terminus or the train station, you will find plenty of nearby taxis. Ask the driver to take you to the address that was emailed to you before your arrival (good advice - don't just say "St. Clare's" as the driver might take you to a different part of the campus). This should cost no more than £10.

Airport Transfers
